Contest Instructions . . .



Food, new toys and Canadian Tire money to be collected by students and faculty between the dates of November 14th to December 14th.

\$1 of Canadian Tire money will be equivalent to \$1. 1 pound of food is equivalent to \$2.50 and 1 pound of new toys is equivalent to \$15. Totals will reflect money, new toys and food combined to determine the total value of the donation in dollars (NOTE: toys are to be new and unwrapped - clothing will not count in the total - clothing can be brought to our partners at the Nearly New Store on Queen Street).

Prize winners will be determined by the total amount of goods donated (dollar value) divided by the total number of students enrolled to reflect a value per student ratio. The school with the highest value per student ratio will be declared the winner (see above for prize details). Winners will be revealed at the Good News Breakfast on Friday, December 16th held at the Niagara College Maid of the Mist campus in Niagara Falls.

Niagara Falls Transit will pick up the proceeds from participating schools located north of the Niagara Veterans Memorial Highway on Wednesday, December 14th between the times 9am and 3pm. Participating schools located south of the Niagara Veterans Memorial Highway will be picked up on Thursday, December 15th between the times of 9am and 3pm.
